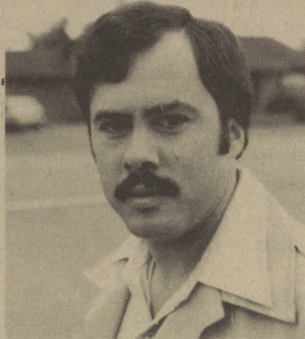


Salem park-and-ride starts somewhat slowly

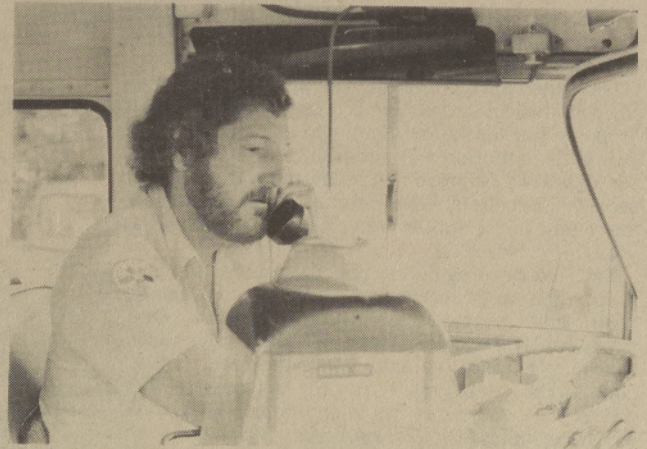


Park here and ride.

The turnout for the first day of the State's new park and ride program in Salem the first day was small but enthusiastic. At the 45th and State Street location three persons made the

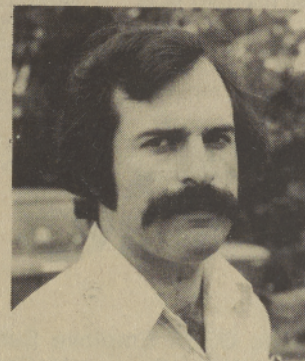

first trip, 11 rode the second run and five were on the final trip to the downtown mall area.

Among them was Harry Eubanks, PUC, who likes the convenience. "I think it's a good way to avoid the parking problems down by the mall. I hope more people take advantage of it" he said.

Pointing to the steady stream of cars heading into the city on State Street, Eubanks pointed out that most had only one occupant.

John Marks, DOT, who normally rides his bicycle to work in the summer said he rode the bus to help the program get off the ground. In the winter he participates in a carpool but he's glad they started the bus service. "I think it's the only thing they could do

since there's no parking around the work area," he said.

Forrest Anderson, one of two drivers alternate between the

East Salem and Keizer park and ride routes also likes the program. He said it only takes about seven minutes to get downtown from the East Salem lot. After three stops in the mall area, he then goes to the Keizer lot for the second trip and back to the East Salem for the third. The other driver follows the opposite pattern.

One advantage that may become more apparent when the winter rains begin is being dropped off close to the work area, while some persons who drive have long walks to their place of employment.
