



Oregon citizens' committee to aid J.P. Stevens boycott

A Citizens Committee for Justice for J. P. Stevens Workers has formed to conduct boycott support activities in the Portland Metropolitan area.

Roger Yockey, an employee representative for the Oregon State Employees Association (OSEA), has been elected committee chairperson and Susie Conley, president of Local

291, Amalgamated Clothing and Textile Workers Union (ACTWU), AFL-CIO, has been elected secretary.

The committee was activated at an August 24 meeting in Portland. Artha Adair, ACTWU staff director for the J.P. Stevens boycott in the Northwest, outlined at the meeting the boycott activities in the Northwest and throughout the nation.

Labor, church, civil rights,

political, senior citizen groups throughout the nation are supporting the struggle of J.P. Stevens workers for social and economic justice.

OSEA lobbyist Bill Wyatt will describe the work the Association is doing in support of the Board of Directors' position in opposition to the property tax limitation measure.

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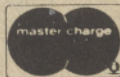
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Reclass approved for aides

Reclassifications to psychiatric security aide were approved by the July Emergency Board for 102 psychiatric aides.

Upgrading these positions has been a matter of primary concern of OSEA for over a year and a half and has received the attention of OSEA Employee Representative Ken Allen, Personnel and Classification Analyst Eleanor Meyers, lobbyist Bill Wyatt and a former employee representative.

The reclassification will affect 85 workers at Fairview, primarily in Gaines Cottage, and 17 workers at Oregon State Hospital.

In addition to the salary increase, the reclassification recognizes the danger of the work performed by the psych security aides. They are in constant -- and locked-in -- contact with court-committed patients and residents, men and women who had been charged with all manner of crime from arson to murder. In effect, they are performing work similar to correctional officers with the added component that their charges also are mentally retarded or mentally ill. The reclassification makes their pay approach that of the correctional officers.

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
