

## Legislators were graded on how they voted on these bills:

### *The Loophole Lobby:*

For the past couple of decades, Oregon has been giving away more and more of its revenue to special interests through tax loopholes. The Loophole Lobby has succeeded in creating over 350 different tax breaks. Oregon now gives away half of our tax revenue to these special interests. Revenue is way down while services SEIU members provide have been slashed, leaving Oregon's most vulnerable people at risk. We need to stop creating new tax loopholes and revisit the ones we have on the books to insure they are living up to the benefits they claim to bring.

### *Workers' Rights:*

Every legislative session we work hard to move a pro-worker agenda. Workers' Compensation, family medical leave and workers' rights are all issues members testified about at the legislature. Some bills, like SB 321 - that would have given Oregon Youth Authority and other public safety officers the right to bargain over safety issues on the job - passed the Senate but were killed by the anti-worker leadership in the House.

### *Health Care:*

Skyrocketing health care costs affect every Oregonian and impair our ability to get raises. We took the lead this year and put health care at the top of the legislative agenda. Our allies in the Senate passed several key pieces of legislation, like SB 329, only to be blocked in the House. SB 329 would have opened our State-run drug purchasing pool to more seniors and small businesses, saving millions with expanded purchasing power. But we were successful in forcing the leadership in the House to pass some pro-worker health care reforms. Members from all over the State put pressure on the House leaders, and even marched on the business of one of them, making it clear the people of Oregon would hold them accountable if they did not act.
