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THE L T HARRIS BILL.

An Act to Aid in Support University and to levy Tax Therefor.

Hon L T Harris, our energetic representative from Lane has introduced the following bill in the house which if enacted into law will provide an annual fund of \$50,000 a year in support of the state university. The bill is house bill No 25 and reads:

A BILL.

For an act to aid in the support of the University of Oregon, and to levy a tax therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the state of Oregon:

Section 1. That there be, and is hereby, levied an annual tax of two-fifths of one million the dollar upon all the taxable property within this state for university purposes; and it is hereby made the duty of the Governor, Secretary of State, and State Treasurer, each year, after ascertaining in the manner now provided, or which may hereafter be provided by law, the rate of taxation in mills and decimals of a mill, to be levied for state purposes, to add thereto the tax hereby levied, and the same shall be collected as other state taxes are collected, and paid into the state treasury, and kept separate from other funds, and shall be known as the university fund.

Section 2. That the fund arising from said tax, or so much hereof as, hereby, may be necessary, be, and the same is appropriated annually or the support and maintenance of the University of Oregon, and to keep the buildings, grounds, and other property thereof in repair, and for the construction of buildings and additions to the library and laboratory facilities.

Section 3. That all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed; provided, such repeal shall not affect the present income of the university under the act appropriating money therefor, or in aid thereof, until the tax herein provided for shall be levied and collected.

Exchanges.

The Athletic Association of Albany college has been reorganized and they expect to begin training soon for the field meet in June.

Two new intercollegiate associations have been proposed; one a debating league, and the other an athletic association. Those who propose this scheme argue that the smaller colleges of Oregon should compete for honors among themselves because they stand no chance with the numerically stronger institutions.

The Junior class, of Pacific University, will publish an annual this year. The class of 1894 of that institution got out "The Heart of Oak," the first college annual in Oregon.—O. A. C. Barometer.

There was a mock trial at the Eutaxian Society Friday afternoon. One of the young ladies was arraigned for "grafting" an overcoat belonging to one of the Laureans. Several of the Laureans were present and the case was ably handled by them, the Eutaxian ladies sitting as a jury. After a thorough examination of witnesses and touching appeals to the jury, the prisoner was acquitted.

The final football report for Berkeley showed a balance of over \$5000 in the treasury. This, with receipts from other minor sources, was sufficient to wipe out the indebtedness of \$5,400 under which the student body has labored during the past year.
