## ENTHUSIASTIC RALLY HELD

Two Hundred and Fifty Students Participate in Friday Night's "Arousment."

That the Oregon spirit, which has been so manifest in past years still exists, was demonstrated Friday night in the first big rally of the year. Class feeling was forgotten and Freshmen joined in with upper classmen to show their loyalty to the University and her football team. The affair was the largest of its kind ever held here, which speaks well for student spirit, considering the fact that the game which it preceded was the most unimportant on Oregon's schedule.

By seven o'clock fully two hundred and fifty boys had congregated at the dormitory ready for the celebration. Under the leadership of Arthur Van Dusen and his aides they formed into line and marched down Eleventh street singing songs, burning lights, shouting yells, and in general giving vent to their exuberance. Arriving at Willamette street they broke into the serpentine dance, and for half an hour held forth along the street which was lined with a great crowd of onlookers. The Eugene band here joined them and after playing Boola Boola, led the way back to Kincaid field where the freshmen had prepared a monster bonfire. The grandstand and sidewalks were filled with co-eds. and townpeople who had come out to witness the demonstration. The students formed around a raised platform, and amid wild enthusiasm, speeches were here given by Regent Friendly, ex-football manager Dave Graham, Ray Goodrich, Bill Hayward, Coach Frost and George Hug. They were all marked by an enthusiastic feeling and calculated to arouse in the hearers a still greater Oregon spirit. At the close of the speeches the band again enlivened the scene with appropriate music, after which the students danced the serpentine on the field, finishing it with a great "Oregon and Osky Wow Wow" when they dispersed to meet again at the morrow's game.
