## Rhodes Scholarship.

On Tuesday and Wednesday, January 21 and 22, the presidents of the various colleges of Oregon met at the University as a committee in charge of the Rhodes scholarship preliminary examinations. Only one applicant presented himself this year as compared to five last year. Cornelius Beebe, '09, of the University of Oregon was examined by the committee and if he passes successfully, will be on the eligible list with Bolton Hamble and Cecil Lyons who took the examination last year. The final selection will be made on a basis of representative scholarship.

While the presidents of the colleges of the state were in Eugene for the purpose of giving the Rhodes Scholarship examination, they met with Pres. P. L. Campbell of the University in order to regulate the requirements for entrance. Nothing definite was accomplished, however, as they decided to postpone action until June at the State Teachers' Convention.
