Interesting Meeting.

Friday night was especially interesting to those who attended the meeting of the Laurean Society. Dr. Leonard delivered an address on the subject of "Athletics" contrasting the English and German systems, beginning with sports of the middle ages. As an essential difference between the two systems Dr. Leonard pointed out that the Germans exercise for the development it gives the body and not so much for sport.

The athletic games with lengthy codes of rules, and which develop phenomenal stars, are of English origin and have reached such a standard in the United States that a man must have years of training to even hope to make a place in them. In conclusion the speaker urged the plea for a different attitude of mind among the students and one which shall give more attention to the development of the modestly endowed student who comes without previous training. Delivered in his concise, clear-cut style and with flawless logic the remarks of Dr. Leonard made a deep impression.
