Y. M. C. A. meeting was addressed Friday evening by Mr. Percy P. Adams on the topic: "A Reasonable Christianity." A small but appreciative audience listened to the lecture, which was full of helpful suggestions. Mr. Adams spoke from the text, Romans 12:7, emphasizing the phase of "reasonable service."

"This being the age of reason," said the speaker, "everything, even Christianity, is closely scrutinized. But the most careful study only serves to emphasize the fact that Christ asks nothing unreasonable from those that follow him.

"We have two natures, the spiritual and the physical. Both are to be developed; neither should grow at the expense of the other. As Paul says, we are to present our bodies 'a living sacrifice' and further to be 'transformed by the renewal of the mind.' We are God's, 'bought with a price,' and should be subject to his will. The Bible is our best guide. Our work should be done with an eye single to God's glory. The service of Christ is a reasonable service. Let us do it ungrudgingly and because we owe it."
