ditions, besides the usual running expenses. The cottage which was built for the women must be furnished, lighted and heated. The library needs at least \$10,000 annually for several years, in order to build it up to meet the needs of the institution. \$10,000 to \$15,000 annually will be required for new instructors in order to increase the number of courses.

A girl's dormitory will take \$50,000 and in this connection might be mentioned the long felt want of a girl's gymnasium. Another building will be necessary for classes and laboratories, especially when the teaching force is increased and new courses introduced. This building would cost about \$75,000. The power and water plant is already overtaxed and will need at least \$10,000 to \$15,000 more to meet the demand upon it for heating, irrigating and fire protection.

The campus must be enlarged and the land bought as quickly as possible on account of the steadily increasing price of real estate.

All these improvements will cost from \$125,000 to \$150,000, so the money must be handled very carefully and everything can not come at once.

The procession of students formed at the dormitory and proceeded three hundred strong to town, where headed by a brass band, and marshalled by student officers, they paraded the streets. Immediately a pyrotechnic display of unusual beauty was carried out with fireworks donated by Kay's Gun Store. The men then came to the center of the field, where by the light of an immense bonfire they listened to speeches by President Campbell, Allen Eaton, L. R. Alderman, S. H. Friendly and Mayor Matlock. All sounded the note of rejoicing. Cheers were given for everyone, even the enemies of the University. Especial gratitude was manifested by all toward Portland and Multnomah county.

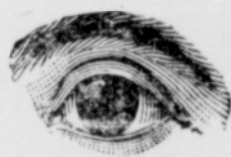
