no free trips. Much of his time that should be spent on college work is devoted to his newspaper thus detracting from his collegiate standing. His class work therefore suffers and an unsympathetic faculty offers him no encouragement.

There are many enduring motives why the editor of the Oregon Weekly should receive credit. Primary is the reason that each year the duties of the editor grow more arduous as the standard of the paper is raised. In a rapidly growing college like the University of Oregon the duties of the editor annually assume a wider scope. Unless some provision is made to remedy the situation, in years to come it will be difficult to get the best men for this office.

For the good of the Oregon Weekly and the University of Oregon, the editor in the future should either receive credit from the faculty or a salary from the students. At present there is no stimulation to raise the standard of the publication. Each year more and more does it seem that the labors of the college newspaper man die unappreciated.

To alleviate this, to encourage and stimulate the editor to higher endeavors a remedy should by all means be thought out. The proper remedy seems to be college credit; but if certain members of the faculty stubbornly refuse to grant this then the editor should be granted a salary. The matter is worthy of the earnest attention of every student who will be in the University of Oregon next year.

The Oregon State Teachers Association will meet in Eugene the week after Commencement.
