### Explicates Lord's Prayer

At the meeting of the Y. M. C. A. on Friday evening Jesse H. Bond gave the association a short talk on "The Lord's Prayer." He said: "In prayer we generally ask for those things which are uppermost in our minds; and the Lord's prayer is a statement of those things which were uppermost in the mind of Jesus. The beginning of the prayer, which opens with the words, 'Our Father,' shows the fervent reverence and love which Jesus always held for the Divine Father.

"The phrase, 'Thy kingdom come,' expresses the fundamental thought which should rule the lives of all men. Jesus was once asked in what the kingdom of God consisted; and he answered that it was within the hearts of men. And so it is that we should try to make God king within us. If God is the ruling force in our hearts there can be no doubt concerning the righteousness and purity of our lives.

"Give us this day our daily bread,' is an old cry for Divine care, coming from the heart of man in his struggle for sustenance. 'Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.' It is often a hard matter to forgive others as we expect to be forgiven; but unless we do forgive others with a willing heart we should not expect complete forgiveness for ourselves.

"Lead us not into temptation,' is an expression of the weakness of man, and his liability to sin if confronted by evil influences. The best way to avoid sin is to keep out of temptation.

"The prayer closes with the sublime acknowledgment of the higher power and glory of God; 'For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever.'"
