Correspondence Department

Along with the increased finances of the University the correspondence school is flourishing vigorously. A large number of students is enrolled this year and much beneficial work is being done throughout the state. The work of this department is carried on mostly to get the teachers in the different localities of the state to organize into groups for the purpose of more thorough study and discussion of the correspondence lessons. This movement has met with some success and organizations are already perfected in the counties of Crook, Coos and Washington. Some of the Women's Clubs of the state are also taking up the work and an effort is being made to get the grangers interested along this line. The courses offered cover the subjects of English Literature, History, Mathematics, and Botany, and a course in Mechanical Drawing is soon to be offered.

It was charged largely during the recent campaign for the appropriation that the University is a benefit only to the more wealthy classes of the state. Whatever slight semblance of truth there might have been in that statement, is overthrown by the fact that through the correspondence department the University is reaching out into every walk of life. It is the professed purpose of the department to help the preparatory students, teachers, women's clubs, grangers and home makers of the state and when this ideal is completely realized the school will stand nearer than ever to the hearts of the people of Oregon.

Among the political speakers who have been canvassing Lane County during the campaign, are Henry McKinney, University of Oregon, '07, who has spoken for Taft, and Bolton Hamble, '08, and Horton Nicholas, '10, who have spoken for Bryan.
