## HUG PICKS ALL-STAR TEAMS

Chooses All-Northwest and All-Ore-  
gon Teams at the Request of  
Oregon Weekly

Geo. W. Hug, '07, has selected for the Oregon Weekly all-star football teams for the Northwest and for Oregon. Mr. Hug is a recognized authority in football in which sport he established his reputation during five years of work on Oregon teams. He himself made a place as center on a similar theoretical team in 1905, and again in 1906. In the former year he was by all authorities given the place over the famous Dow Walker of O. A. C. It was in the same year that Overfield, the great All-American star, pronounced Hug the best center against whom he had ever played.
