

Oregon 22. On a basis of the number of students registered Washington expends \$43.08 per student for equipment alone; South Dakota, \$363.63; Idaho, about \$35.00; California, \$17.84; Montana \$600.00, while Oregon follows with the munificent sum of \$4.54 per student.

As a matter of comparison with states which realize the importance of their state institution in furthering the general development of their state, the state of Colorado appropriates more for her school of mines than Oregon appropriates for her whole State University. The value of the plant of the Colorado State School of Mines at Golden is \$550,000.00.
