Chemawa's Superintendent is well housed. The Cottage is centrally located and surrounded with Oregon firs and roses in profusion.

The Chemawa School was organized by Major Wilkinson at Forest Grove, Feb. 27, 1884, or about 6 months after the Caribde school was started. It was moved to its present location in 1885, when 25 of the Indian young men came here and broke the ground. From this small band of 25 Indian Pioneers the school has grown to 60, being the second oldest and the fourth in size. Chemawa gives special attention to Industrial Training and offers exceptional Industrial advantages.
