In the shoe and harness shop nothing touch is attempted beyond harnessmaking, shoemaking, saddlery and repairing. For the past six years this department has taken the first prize at the Oregon State Fair against all comers for the excellence of Chemawa's harness and saddles.

The engineer has charge of steam heating, electric lighting, the power which runs the laundry and shops, the pumping of water, etc., etc., and in this department a young man has excellent chances.

The gardener has charge of the gardening and Chemawa's nice orchard.

The poultry department does not appear under the head of Chemawa's faculty, but this position is well filled by Mr. Ousman, our tailor, who thoroughly understands poultry raising and the care of them.
