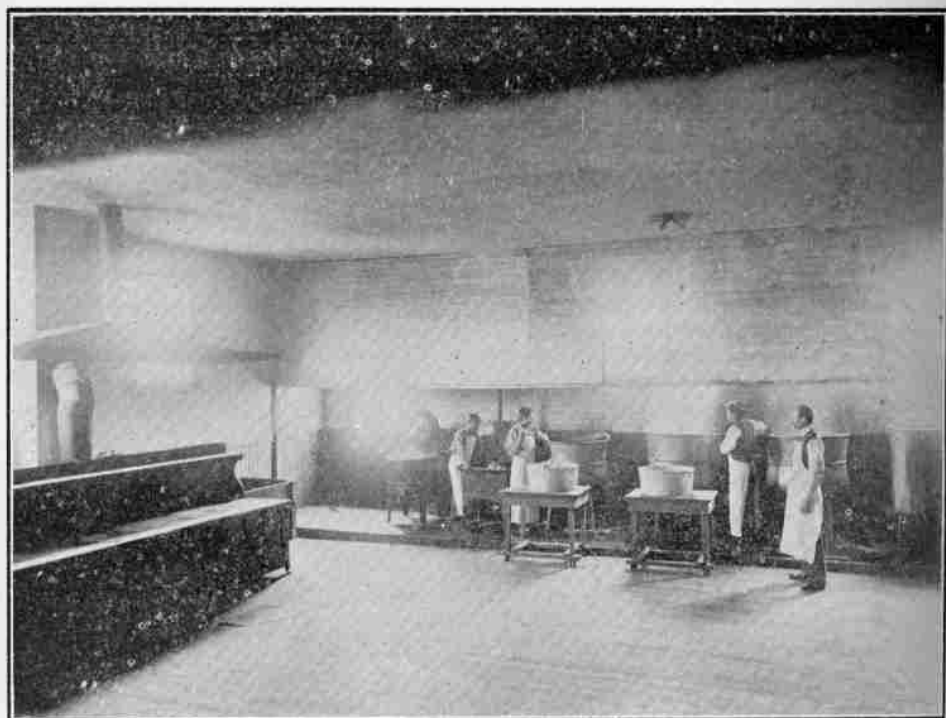




A CORNER OF CHEMAWA'S KITCHEN.

The kitchen is a very important part of an Indian school.

Chemawa's is located on the second floor of the building and the food is delivered to the serving room at the rear end of the dining room by means of elevators.

The most of the food is cooked by means of steam supplied from the power house.

In addition to a large range the kitchen is furnished with steam roasters, vegetable cookers, steam cauldrons, coffee and tea urns, etc.

A preparing room is attached and pantries, fruit closets, etc., all occupy the second floor of the building, which is convenient and up-to-date.
