Seven hundred and twenty-seven allottees at Pine Ridge Agency will receive this summer the articles promised under the Sioux Treaty of some years ago. There will be issued 6380 heifers, 816 mares, 816 milk cows, 816 sets of harness, 408 wagons and 408 each of plows, harrows, rakes and other farm implements. Three hundred and nineteen allottees have petitioned for, and been allowed to take 20 heifers each, in lieu of other articles to which they were entitled.--Weekly Review.
