The right is reserved to reject any or all bids, or any part of any bid if deemed for the best interests of the Service. The supplies offered for delivery under contract will be rigidly inspected. Each bid must be accompanied by certified check or draft on some United States Depository or solvent national bank, made payable to the order of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, for at least five per cent of the amount of the proposal, which check or draft shall be forfeited to the United States in case a bidder receiving an award shall fail to execute promptly a satisfactory contract in accordance with his bid, otherwise to be returned to the bidder.
