History of the Class of 1909.

We organized our class in our Junior year, elected our officers and chose our motto "Victory, Labor's Crown," and selected purple and gold as our class colors. And now a few words regarding each member.

Levi Sortor, the president of the class, entered the school in 1895, a very little boy at that time. His home was in Washngton.
