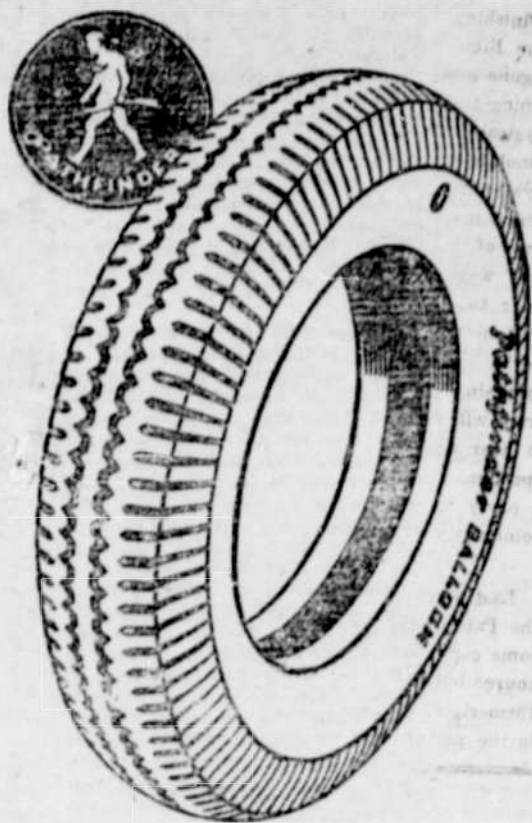

Surprise Grange held their regular meeting Saturday, at which time G. W. Farris gave his report on the proceedings of the State Grange.

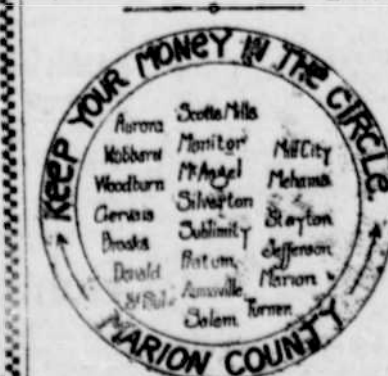
