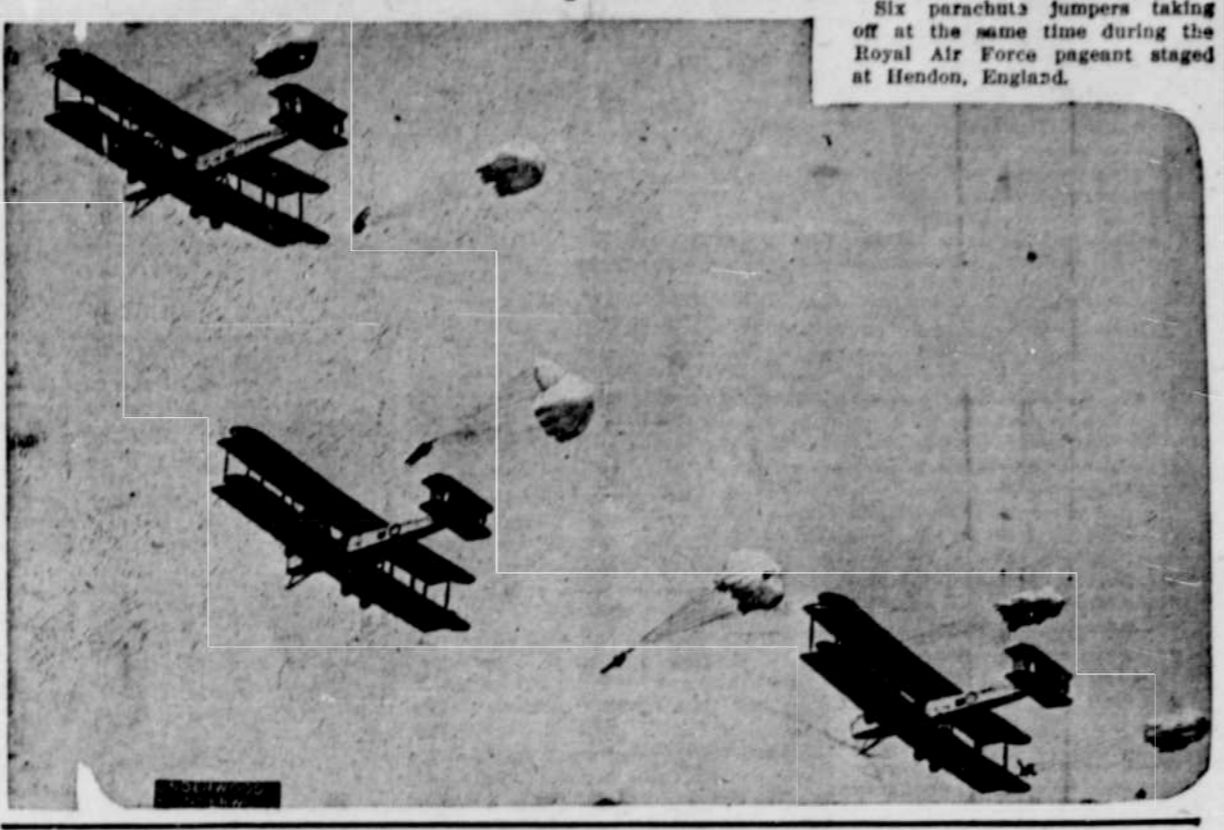
Will Learn From Expert

Jud Tunkins says he has made money enough to give him a banker for social position. So he's going far away from home for a while and get a job as a butler, so's to learn what good manners are really like.

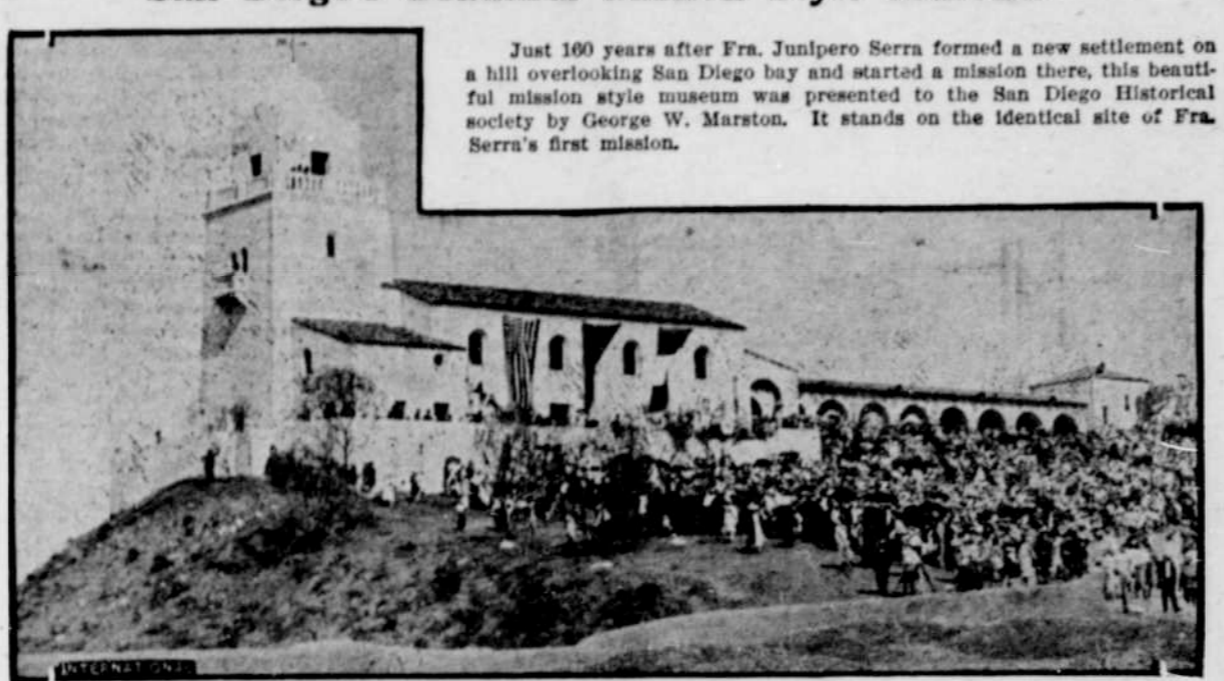
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Six Parachute Jumpers Take Off at Once

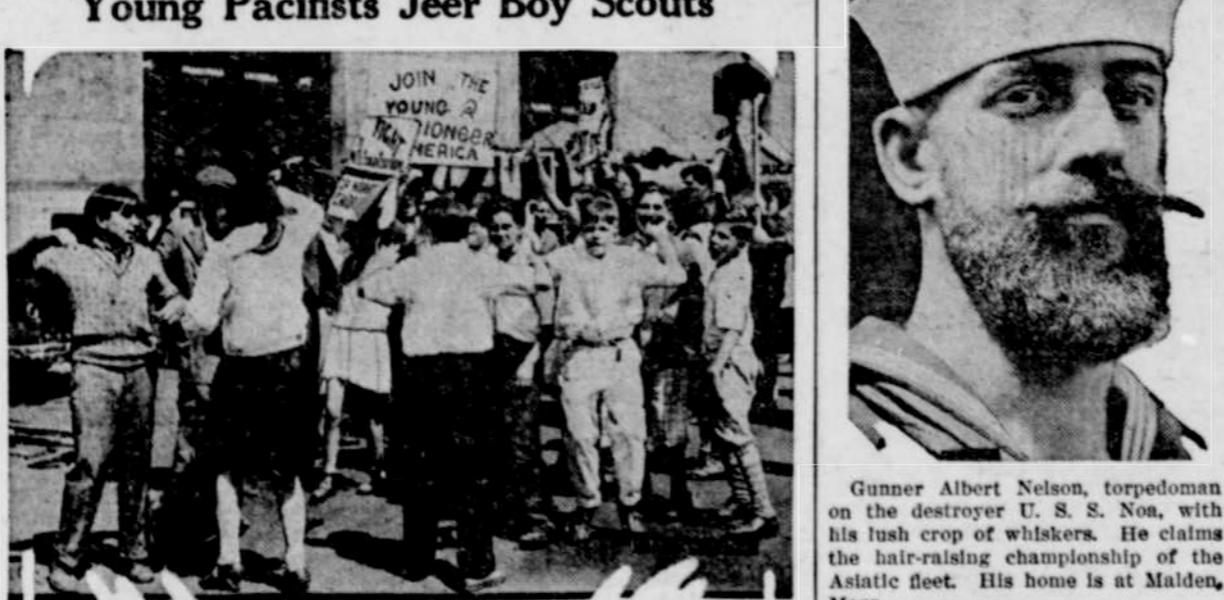
