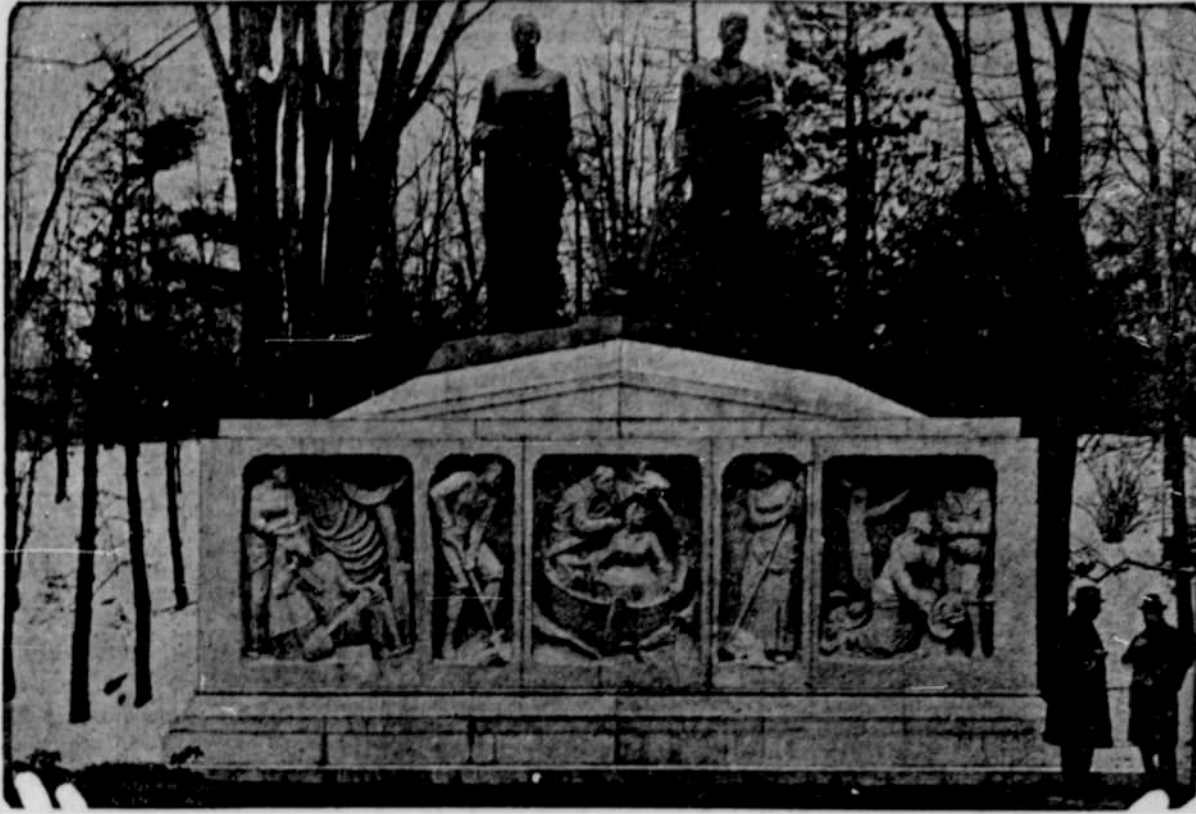

One of the most important activities of the Department of Agriculture, that of crop reporting, was one of the first undertakings of the department, and was established in 1862. This work has grown from its humble beginning until now more than 70 crops are reported on regularly.

The benefits to the public and to the producers have been inestimable. Overproductions of various products have been held down to reasonable limits where the advice of the bureau was heeded and the forecast shortages to some extent have been met.

Fresh vegetables, which once were reasonable articles of trade and almost prohibitive in price during the off seasons, are sold the year 'round at reasonable prices through the work of the bureau, along with the development of the refrigerator car. As the years go on, this work is expected to grow more and more vital to the well being of the farmer and to keeping the consumers supplied at all times with a high grade of product.—Washington Post.
