

Fresh vegetables, which once were seasonable articles of trade and al most prohibitive in price during the off seasons, are sold the year 'round at reasonable prices through the work of the bureau, along with the development of the refrigerator car. As the years go on, this work is expected to grow more and more vital to the well being of the farmer and to keeping with a high grade of product.-Washington Post.
