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Frame and Axle Straightening
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Ordinance No. 73

An ordinance to provide for the good conduct, good order, peace and cleanliness of the Town.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Turner, Oregon:

Section 1. That no person under the age of sixteen years shall be permitted to go abroad upon or wander about the streets or alleys, or public places of the Town after the hour of 9 o'clock, P. M., unless such person shall have the permission of the parent or guardian in writing, or shall be accompanied by such parent or guardian and it is hereby made the duty of the Town Marshal to warn all such persons of this, fifteen minutes to 9 o'clock

Section 2. All persons who shall violate the above section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder, shall be punished for the first offense by a public reprimand by the Recorder; and for each succeeding offense by a fine not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00. And in all cases where such person shall fail to pay such fine imposed upon him under the provisions of this section, he shall be imprisoned one day for every \$2.00 of such fine, in the city jail.

Ordinance No. 74

An ordinance regulating the sale and prohibiting the discharging of fire crackers and other fire works within the corporate limits of the City of Turner.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Turner, Oregon:

Section 1. The Common Council of the City of Turner, does, by this Ordinance declare it unlawful to offer for sale any fire crackers or other fire works on any date except on July 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to discharge, within the City limits of the City of Turner, Oregon, any fire crackers or other fire works except on July 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

Section 3. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined any sum not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$10.00, and in default thereof be imprisoned in the City jail until such fine is paid at the rate of one day for each \$2.00 of such fine.
