Ordinance No. 73

An ordinance to provide for the good conduct, good order, peace and cleanliness of the Town.

Be it ordained by the Common Coun-

cil of the City of Turner, Oregou: Section 1. That no person under the age of sixteen years shall be permitted to go abroad upon or wander about the streets or alleys, or public places of the Town after the hour of 9 In The Name Of The State Of Ore- o'clock, P. Ordinance No. 74

An ordinance regulating the sale and prohibiting the discharging of fire crackers and other fire works within the corporate limits of the City of Turner.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Turner, Oregon; Section 1. The Common Council of the City of Turner, does, by this Ordinance declare it unlawful to offer for sale any fire crackers or other fire works on any date except on July 2, 3,

4, 5 and 6, Section 2. It thall be unlawful for any person or persons to discharge, within the City limits of the City of Turner, Oregon, any fire crackers or other fire works except on July 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

Section 3. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined any sum not less than \$2.09 nor more than \$10.00, and in default thereof be imprisoned in the City jail until such fine is paid at the rate of one day for each \$2.00 of such fine. Adopted June 3rd, 1931.
