After this his hours of freedom were short. Not knowing that Goodwin's body had risen to condemn him Brichoux purchased a big consignment of liquor and reported that he was going to Burns. Sheriff Brown had the road's watched and placed Deputy Noe on the Vale bridge. About 10 o'clock Brichoux crossed the bridge and refused to halt when ordered to do so by Noe, who at once notified Sheriff Brown. Brown and Chief Harry Farmer of Ontario and Frank Alison, who were in Vale then gave chase and a wild race was run to this city The sheriff made the trip in 30 minutes but Brichoux detoured and ditched his car near the oil well south of the city and walked home eluding the guards at his home.

It was from his own family that he first heard of the finding of Goodwin's body and he immediately, realizing the futility of further efforts to escape, sent his son to notify Mr. Farmer that he wanted to surrender. Mr. Farmer made the arrest and the confession followed.

Brichoux has a wife and five children, one a married daughter, another a school teacher, one son and daughter are pupils in the high school and the youngest is a pupil in the grades.

When Goodwin's body was first found the only identification mark was that of a laundry mark, 70x. The clothes were identified by a young woman friend, who it is said he was to marry October 7. Further identification was furnished by Dr. Howe who recognized some dental
