Experience of Europe Aids the United States.

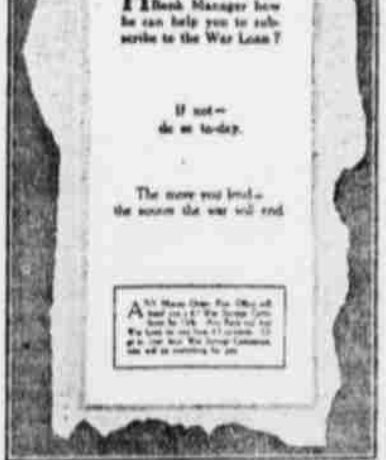
WARRING COUNTRIES SOUND
