September 29th, 1917, the board of directors of the Payette-Oregon Slope Irrigation District will receive sealed proposals at their office in Malheur County, State of Oregon, said office being located in the one story frame dwelling house of the said district more particularly described as being located in the southeast quarter of north west quarter of section 2, township 17 south range 47 EWM in Malheur County, Oregon, for the purchase of bonds of the said district as follows:

Twenty year negotiable coupon bonds of Payette-Oregon Slope Irrigation District in the sum and amount of \$190,000.00 to refund, cancel and retire all outstanding bonds of the district as well as all outstanding coupons on bonds and all warrants issued for interest on bonds; said refunding bonds to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum interest payable the first day of January and July of each year, the bonds maturing serially after the fifth year in annual amounts so as to be approximately equal principal and interest, and
