FINAL CALL COMES TO GRAND ARMY VETERAN

Seth E. A. Leavitt Taken Suddenly Ill Dies of Heart Failure-Ten Children Survive Him

Seth E. A. Leavitt, aged 72 years, veteran of the Civil War, and well known citizen of Malheur county died suddenly at his home Southwest of Ontario, Wednesday Dec. 5. Death was due to heart failure and the end came as a distinct shock to the family and the host of friends of the deceased.

Until the evening before, in spite of his age, Mr. Leavitt had enjoyed good health. The indisposition he first felt was so slight that on Wednesday afternoon he arose and had started to dress when he was stricken.

Mrs. Leavitt who was with him endeavored to restore him in vain and he died before medical aid could be summoned. Funeral services were held from the United Presbyterian church Wednesday afternoon of this week having been delayed pending the arrival of his daughter, Mrs. Hadley from Baldwin, Kansas.

Seth E. A. Leavitt was born in Dunkirk, New York, Sept. 4th, 1845. In 1853 he moved with his parents to Wyandotte, Kansas.

During the Civil War he served in the Federal army, although but a mere boy. On Oct. 15th, 1862, when

a little more than seventeen years of age, he enlisted in Co. G., 12th Kan. Inf., and was mustered out June 13th, 1865, at Little Rock, Ark.

On Oct. 19th, 1875 he married Miss Sarah E. Blanton, who with ten children survive him. Two other children, the eldest of the family, David E. and Mary E., dying in infancy. Those remaining are: Geo. W., Boise, Ida., Mrs. Liddia G. Hadley, Baldwin City, Kan., Chas. S., Ontario, Elmer W., Portland, Ore., Edwin A., Hutchinson, Kan., Mrs. Sadie G. Cramp, Phoenix, Ariz., Wm. E., Walter B., Frank J., and Mrs. Francis H. A. McGregor, all of Ontario.

Mr. Leavitt, with his family, moved to Malheur Co., Ore., in 1881. In 1882 they returned to Kan., where they remained until 1899, when they again came to Oregon, where he resided until his death, Dec. 5th, 1917, at the age of 72 yrs., 3 months and one day.

Compressed Air Sends Missiles Into German Trenches
