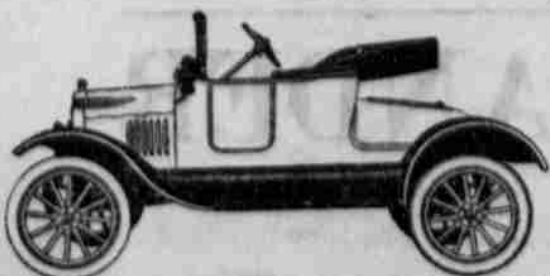

ORDINANCE NO. 315.

An ordinance ordering the construction of a Lateral Service Sewer within the City of Ontario, as follows: Beginning at the intersection of Idaho Avenue and Malheur street, thence southerly along Malheur street, to the south boundary of the City Limits, then easterly along said boundary line of said City to the eastern boundary of said city limits, thence northerly along the east line of said city limits to the intersection of Idaho Avenue, thence westerly along Idaho Avenue to the place of beginning.

The conduit pipe of said proposed lateral sewer to be six inches in diameter, and to be fitted with "Y" connections where necessary, and containing an emergency provision.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ONTARIO DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a Lateral Service Sewer be constructed as follows: Beginning at the intersection of Idaho Avenue and Malheur street in the City of Ontario, Malheur County, Oregon, thence south along said Malheur street to its intersection with the South Boundary of the City and thence easterly along said City boundary line to the east boundary line of said City, thence north along said east boundary line of said city to its intersection with Idaho Avenue, thence west along said Idaho Avenue to the point of beginning.

The conduit pipe of said Lateral Sewer be six inches in diameter, and must be joined and in place and accepted by the committee on Streets, Sewers and Drains, on the part of the City of Ontario before the same is

covered, and must be laid with sufficient fall to insure complete drainage into Trunk Sewer No. 2, and must be fitted with "Y" connections wherever necessary.

SECTION 2. That when the probable cost of the construction of said Sewer has been duly ascertained and determined by the Council, and the proportionate share thereof of each lot has been determined, and the same shall be assessed, the lien thereof created shall be enforced in the manner in this ordinance provided.

SECTION 3. The proportionate share that each lot is liable for of the cost of construction of said Sewer shall be declared and assessed against each lot by Ordinance, which shall set down the name of the owner of said lot if known, or if not known that the owner is unknown, a description of the property liable for the assessment, describing the same by lots, and the sum assessed against said property.

SECTION 4. That the ownership of the lots so assessed for the cost of the construction of the said lateral service sewer shall be ascertained in the following manner: The Recorder shall obtain a certificate from the County Clerk of Malheur County, Oregon, stating who the owner of said property is at the time of passing of said ordinance making the assessment as provided in the foregoing sections hereof as the same may appear upon the records of deeds of said county, which certificate the County Clerk shall be, and is hereby authorized and required to give when demanded by the City Recorder, when the fees therefor shall be paid by the City to the County Clerk for furnishing the said certificate.

SECTION 5. That the Ordinance assessing the cost of the construction of the lateral service shall direct the Recorder to enter a statement thereof in the City Lien Docket. The City Lien Docket is a book in which must be entered, in pursuance with this Ordinance, and the Charter of the City of Ontario, the following matter in relation to the assessment for the cost of said sewer, viz: First, name of the owner, if known, or that the owner is unknown; Second, a description of the property assessed. Third, the date of the assessment. Fourth, the amount assessed upon such property. The City Lien Docket shall have the force and effect provided for in Section 124 of the Charter of the said City of Ontario and the General Laws of the State of Oregon.

SECTION 6. That from the date of the entry in said City Lien Docket of any assessment upon any property as hereinbefore provided, the sum so entered shall be deemed a tax levy and lien against said property, which shall have priority over any other liens or encumbrances whatsoever thereon.

SECTION 7. A sum of money assessed for the construction of the said Lateral Service Sewer shall be collected in the following manner: Notice shall be given to the owner or reputed owner of the property assessed as named in the lien record in the Docket of City Liens, and that said assessment has been made, and the lien thereof entered of record in the City Lien Docket and that the same is due, and requiring the same to be paid to the City Recorder within ten days of the service of said notice; said notice shall be served by publication in a weekly newspaper published in the City of Ontario, by order of the City Council, in at least two issues of said paper; a notice of such assessment shall be sent by mail to each property owner assessed, when the postoffice address of the owner is known, and such notice shall substantially contain the matters required to be entered in the docket of said liens concerning such assessment.

SECTION 8. If within ten days from the service of a notice or the final publication thereof as prescribed in the foregoing sections of this ordinance the sums assessed upon any lot or parcel of land are not wholly paid to the City Recorder, the Council may thereafter at any time they may see fit order a warrant for the collection of the same issued by the Recorder and directed to the City Marshal. Such warrant shall contain the provisions and be executed and enforced in the manner provided for in Sections 127 and 128 of the Charter of the said City of Ontario,

and the General Laws of the State of Oregon.

SECTION 9. It being essential to the health of the City of Ontario, that proper sewerage facilities should be provided, it is therefore declared that this measure is for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Ontario and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance

shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
