> SECTION 5. That the Ordinance messing the cost of the construction of the lateral service shall direct the Recorder to enter a statement thereof in the City Lien Docket. The City Lien Docket is a book in which must be entered, in pursuance with this Ordinance, and the Charter of the City of Ontario, the following matter in relation to the assessment for the cost of said sewer, viz: First, name of the owner, if known, or that the owner is unknown; Second, a description of the property assessed. Third, the date of the assessment. Fourth, the amount assessed upon such prophave the force and effect provided for in Section 124 of the Charter of the said City of Ontario and the General Laws of the State of Oregon.

SECTION 6. That from the date of the entry in said City Lien Docket of any assessment upon any property as hereinbefore provided, the sum so entered shall be deemed a tax levy and lien against said property, which shall have priority over any other liens or encumbrances whatsoever

SECTION 7. A sum of money assessed for the construction of the said Lateral Service Sewer shall be collected in the following 'manner: Notice shall be given to the awner reputed owner of the proper nase ed as named in the lien record 'n Docket of City Liens, and that said assessment has been made and the lien thereof entered of record in the City Lien Docket and that the same is due, and requiring the same to be paid to the City Recorder within ten days of the service of said notice; said notice shall be served by publication in a weekly newspaper published in the City of Ontario, by order of the City Council, in at least two issues of said paper; a notice of such assessment shall be sent by mail to each property owner assessed. when the postoffice address of the owner is known, and such notice shall, substantially contain the matters required to be entered in the docket of said liens concerning such assess-

ment. SECTION 8. If within ten days from the service of a notice or the final publication thereof as prescribed in the foregoing sections of this ordinance the sums assessed upon any lot or parcel of land are not wholly paid to the City Recorder, the Council may thereafter at any time they may see fit order a warrant for the collection of the same issued by the Recorder and directed to the City Marshal. Such warrant shall contain the provisions and be executed and enforced in the manner provided for in Sections 127 and 128 of the Charter of the said City of Ontario,
