TO THOMAS F. ADAMS AND MARY C. ADAMS, the above named defendants:

IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON: You and each of you are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit on or before six weeks from the date of the first publication of this summons, the same being the last day of the time prescribed by order of the court directing service of summons in said suit to be made upon you by publication; and if you fail so to answer, for want thereof, the plaintiff will apply to the said court for the relief demanded in the said complaint, to-wit:

For judgment against Thomas F. Adams upon a note for \$300 with interest thereon at the rate of 10 per cent per annum from December 26, 1917, until paid, and for \$30 attorney fees, and for plaintiff's costs and disbursements in said suit. And for a decree of the court foreclosing plaintiff's pledge upon life insurance policy number 736932, issued by the Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on the 15th day of January, 1908, on the life of Thomas F. Adams, and made payable to the defendant Mary C. Adams, and pledged by the defendants to the plaintiff on June 6, 1918, for the payment of the above described note, and decreeing that said policy be sold at sheriff's sale and that the proceeds of said sale be applied to the amount due the plaintiff.
