gram to the full \$230,000 by setting aside \$5,000 for the Watson road. **Fairman Discusses Situation.** Jack Fairman of Westfall who had aroused the meeting by declaring: "while Westfall is not touched by this division of funds, if you fellows provide for the building of the main highways we will build to them. We are not poor up our way and can solve that part of the problem."

Following a brief statement by President R. D. Lytle on the proposed division the roll call of the directors was called and the motion as amended by Messrs. Gallagher and Fairman was carried unanimously. It was then submitted to the gathering and carried with one dissenting vote. Before the meeting adjourned Fred Palmer on behalf of Jordan Valley thanked the gathering for its determination to give Jordan Valley a square deal. Mr. Morrill of Malheur presented a petition for signatures requesting a change in mail routes so that mail for communities in Malheur county might move direct and avoid going from Malheur to Ontario and Baker and around 200 miles to reach a destination 14 miles from the point of origin.

A number of bills were allowed and many new members were added to the development league. Just before the gathering adjourned President Lytle made a ringing speech calling for a united effort to put the program over and to get behind every movement initiated within the League for the advancement of any section of the county. To prepare the petitions for circulation Mr. Lytle appointed: District Attorney R. W. Swagler, P. J. Gallagher and Julien A. Hurley. To circulate the petitions: J. A. Kennedy, J. R. Blackaby, F. M. Northrup and G. H. Currey.
