AGED MAN DANGEROUSLY HURT IN ATTEMPT TO CROSS TRACK

David Masoner, aged 71 years, was brot to the Holy Rosary Hospital Tuesday in a dangerous condition as the result of injuries sustained when he attempted to jump between two cars of a freight train standing at a siding in Payette.

The train started just as he reached the coupling and he was knocked between the cars and dragged for several yards sustaining beside a broken foot and leg, two fractured ribs. He was also severely bruised about the body. It is feared that the broken ribs have penetrated his lungs. The train crew picked him up following the accident and brot him to Ontario. The hospital authorities reported yesterday that he was in very serious condition.

After more than a year's illness following successive attacks of influenza which she contracted while living in Enterprise, Mrs. Gertrude Johnson Bradford, died at the home of her parents, Mr. and Amos W. Johnson, on the Island southeast of town, Monday morning. She leaves beside her parents, her husband and an 8 month old baby.

Funeral services were held from the McDowell parlors Tuesday afternoon, Rev. D. T. Mansker officiating. Mrs. Bradford was 21 years of age at the time of her death, having been born in Lincoln county Oklahoma, September 17, 1898. She came to Ontario with her parents several years ago and resided here constantly since, save for a few months following her marriage last year when she lived in Enterprise.
