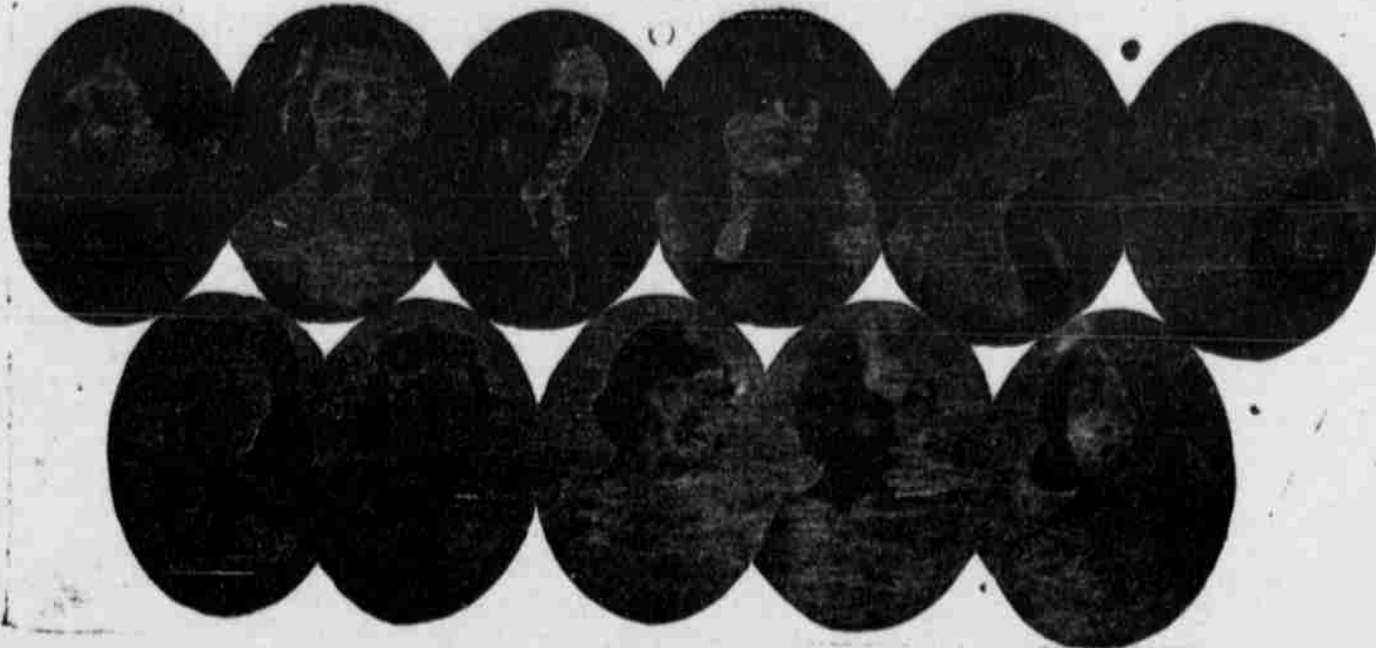

### NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT FOR LATERAL SEWER DISTRICT NO. 10.

STATE OF OREGON,  
County of Malheur,  
City of Ontario.

Pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 331, passed and approved on the first day of December, A. D. 1919, notice is hereby given that the assessments for Lateral Sewer District No. 10 of said City have been levied and entered in the City Lien Docket. The date of such entry is February 28th, 1920. All of said assessments are due and payable within ten (10) days after service of this notice, and if not paid within such time there will be added a penalty of five (5) per cent and such assessment will draw interest at the rate of ten (10) per centum per annum; provided, however, that at any time within said ten day period the owner of any piece of property assessed in the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), or more, may file in the office of the undersigned, City Recorder an application to pay such assessments in ten (10) equal annual installments with interest on the unpaid assessments or installments, thereof, at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually. Forms of such applications may be obtained from the undersigned, City Recorder, and all applications must be made on such forms or others substantially like them. Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Directors of the Warmsprings Irrigation District at their office in Vale, Malheur County, Oregon, at the hour of 2 o'clock P. M., on Tuesday, the 6th day of April, 1920, of the bonds of said District in the sum of \$200,000, dated April, 1920, and immediately thereafter publicly opened for the purchase of the bonds of said District in the sum of \$200,000, dated January 1, 1920, numbered, in denominations and maturing as follows, to-wit:

Said bonds to bear interest at six per cent (6%) per annum, payable semi-annually on the 1st day of July and January, principal and interest payable in U. S. gold coin at the office of the County Treasurer of Malheur County, Oregon, or at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Oregon in New York City, at the option of the holder.

Said bids must be accompanied by a certified check for ten per cent (10%) of the amount bid, same to be forfeited to the District as liquidated damages in the event the successful bidder fails to take up and pay for said bonds within ten days after the award.

Said bids must be unconditional as to legality, and the District will furnish the successful bidder with the approving legal opinion of Messrs. Tol, Minor & Winfree, of Portland, Oregon.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
