NOTICE TO EXTERMI-NATE POCKET GOPHERS

Every firm, co-partnership, company or corporation residing on. owning, leasing, occupying, possess ing or having charge of or dominion over any land, ditches, canals or other property, infested with pocket gophers in Malheur County, Oregon, is hereby notified to begin at once to effectively exterminate and destroy all such pocket gophers.

The following poison for mixing and instructions for use thereof is the method most expedient and effective to be used for the extermination and destruction of such pocket gophers, and is hereby recommended towit, alkaloid strychnine used on either sweet potatoes or carrots, mixed acording to the following formula and manner, to-wit:

Formula for Poisoning Pocket Gophers.


Recommended by U. S. Biological Survey and Extension Service of the Oregon Agricultural College. Grind together in a mortar:

1-8 Ounce powdered strychnine alkeloid.

1-10 Ounce saccharine.

Cut four quarts of sweet potatoes 10.162.62 or carrot baits, one-half inch square and one Inch long, and sprinkle the 2,600.00 above powder over them, stirring

until each bait is coated thoroughly.
