UNTREATED WOUNDS DECAY

To prevent decay that may spread to other parts of the tree, the limb of a tree that is blown off or becomes diseased should be cawed off even with the trunk and painted with creosote or tar paint, say the college horticultural specialists. Sometimes injuries no larger than the head of a nail under the bark will cause the bark to drop off leaving the wood unprotected. Decay will start from these spots and extend until they endanger the tree. If treated with a coat of creosote or tar, decay is stopped, and the bark will grow smoothly over the wound again.

The State University, the Agricultural College and the Oregon Normal School now have 5400 fulltime students. The number does not include any of the thousands of short course, correspondence-study, or summer schools students. 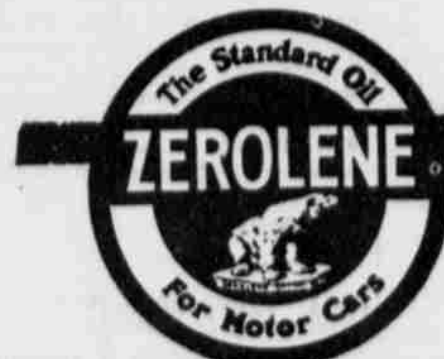

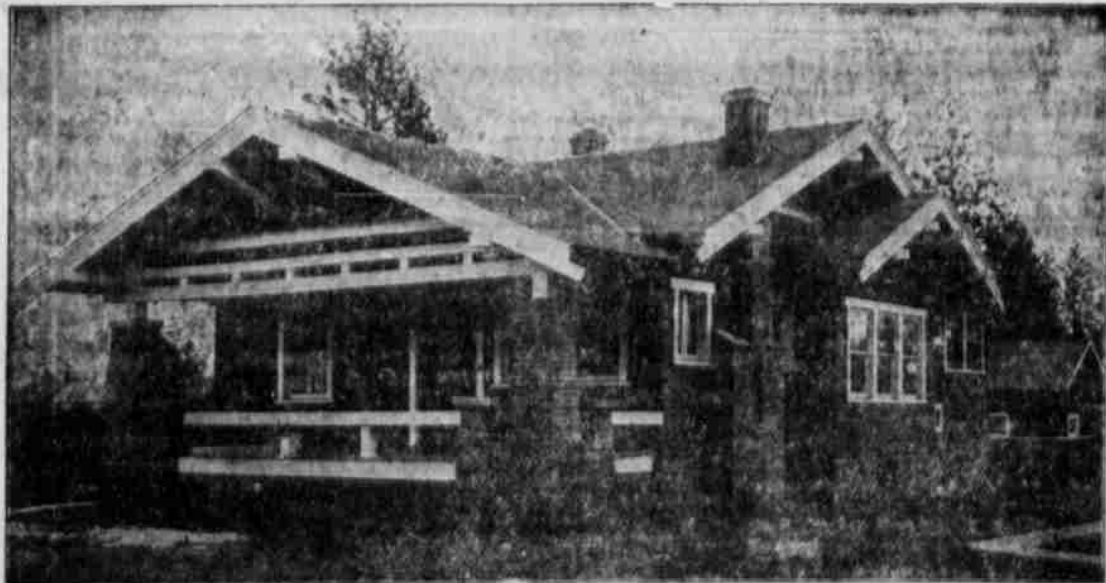
