Notice is hereby given that on the 8th day of April, 1920, Sarah E. Ash, and other whose names more fully appear therein, did file with the Clerk of the above entitled Court their certain petition for the organization of the lands therein designated into an irrigation district pursuant to the laws of the State of Oregon, as follows:

To the Honorable, the County Court for Malheur County, Oregon:

We, the undersigned petitioners, respectfully show and represent:

First:—That we are and each of us are owners of land, situated within the boundaries of the proposed irrigation district, as hereinafter set forth and described and that together, we constitute a majority of the land owners, of the lands within the boundaries of said proposed district.

Second:—That the lands hereinafter described, are susceptible of irrigation from the same source and by the same system of works, viz: by the installation of a pumping plant of 22,000 G. M. P. capacity on the bank of Snake River and distribution of water therefrom through open canals.
