

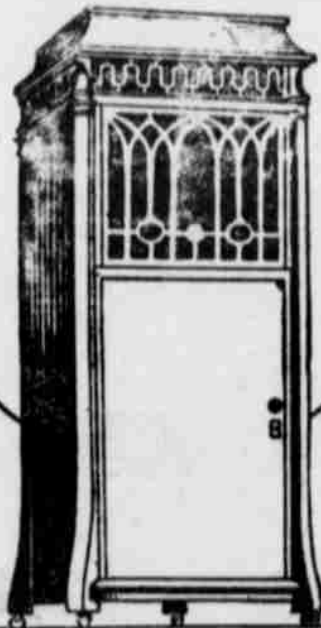

## IDAHO AND UTAH UNIVERSITIES TO BATTLE IN BOISE

Football Teams of Two Institutions to Clash at State Fair Grounds on Armistice Day.

### BIG ATTENDANCE PREPARED FOR

Minimum of 4,000 Expected; Old Favorites From Many Towns Playing; High School Boys Guests.

Boise.—From all over Idaho, interest is being centered on the Armistice day football game to be played, November 11, between the University of Idaho and the University of Utah. Four thousand persons, at the very fewest, are expected to attend. Fans predict that the game will be the biggest in the history of southern Idaho. The gridiron will be laid out at the state fair grounds.

Many towns, both in south and north Idaho, have their old high school stars on the Idaho team. People from remote sections of the state already have indicated their intention to see the two elevens clash. A delegation of at least 100 from Moscow is in view.

High school players from various towns will be admitted to the side lines to watch the contest, under supervision of their own coaches, who will show the students how the big

teams' work. Invitations to the high school squads are being extended, through their own coaches, by the University of Idaho club of Boise.

Not only will the game be a contest between two states, but between members of two great football conferences, the Northwest conference and the Rocky Mountain conference. Plans are being made that a game between the University of Idaho and some other university team shall be

played in Boise each year, on Armistice day, and that such game shall become one of the outstanding features of the yearly sporting calendar of this part of the country.

Interest in the game among college men here is running high, as many of them have not had opportunities to see intercollegiate football since they were graduated. Great interest, also, is reported on the part of people who are not familiar with even the rudiments of football, but who want to see what the excitement is all about. The management announces that it will take particular pains to make the game clear and interesting to them.

Neil Irving, halfback from Rupert, also is playing his last year for Idaho. He was reported to be the most consistent ground gainer in the game against W. S. C., and outpunted Pullman repeatedly, his punts averaging 40 yards to his opponent's 25.
