Rose bushes should be dusted with the finest grade of dusting sulphur as soon as any mildew appears and retreated as soon as a new infection shows up.—O. A. C. Experiment station.

Pasture in the shape of alfalfa, clover, or rape is of great assistance in making cheaper pork. Grain should always be fed with the pasture. The pastures will usually give better results if they are subdivided. The hogs can then be shifted at intervals of 7 to 10 days. The fresh feed gives the animals new heart. If it gets too old or woody chip it down so that fresh tender shoots will come out.
