Summons to each, and all, and every of the defendants above named. IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON: You, and each of you, are hereby notified that Malheur County is the owner and holder of certificates of delinquency numbers 3072 to 3171, inclusive, and of certificates of delinquency numbers 3173 to 3194, inclusive, for taxes due and payable to Malheur County, Oregon, the plaintiff herein, for the year 1917, issued by H. Lee Noe, the tax collector of the County plaintiff herein, on the 5th day of January, A. D. 1922; said certificates of delinquency bearing interest at the rate of twelve per cent (12%) per annum from the date last aforesaid, and hereinafter more fully set forth showing the number of the delinquency certificate and the tract number used in this proceeding, the amount of delinquency, including interest, penalty and costs at the date of issuance, which amounts are claimed to be first liens upon the lands therein described; the description of the tracts of lands included therein, and the name of the owner to whom said tract was assessed in the year 1917 and the name of the person to whom last assessed, as shown by the last assessment roll in the hands of the sheriff of Malheur County, if said owner is other than that given for the year 1917; said lands being described by lots and blocks if town property and by section, township and range if rural property; all townships being south of the Base Line in Oregon and all ranges being east of the Willamette Meridian, and all property herein being situated in Malheur County, Oregon; the several tracts of land described herein are numbered consecutively beginning with number 1 and ending with number 187, and the sum named in each and every tract is the amount of the charge and the lien claimed against the property described in said tract.
