Summary of weather and crop conditions in Eastern Oregon for week ending June 13, 1922. High temperature prevailing with considerable high wind. Harvesting of alfalfa is general. Grains heading early on account of unusual temperature. Corn doing well.

There was an excellent attendance Monday night at the annual school meeting when the budget prepared by the board of directors and budget committee, was accepted by an unanimous vote. R. R. Overstreet was elected director to fill the place vacated by M. L. Parsons. Mrs. Herbert Hickox was elected clerk for the ensuing year.

Final surveys have been made and plans laid for the Nyssa-Jordan Valley Market Road, and running south to the Homedale railroad, running south on the east side of the railroad to Adrian. This gives a water grade for the large tonnage of produce that must at present pass over this road. Work is expected to start on this stretch in the next three weeks. The county court also granted a road south of the Owyhee grade running east one fourth mile to the railroad crossing.
