## PROPOSED SALE OF IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF WARMSPRINGS IRRIGATION DISTRICT, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

For the purpose of improving its irrigation system by construction of a reservoir at or near Riverside, Oregon, on the Malheur river, the Board of Directors of the Warm Springs Irrigation District of Malheur County, Oregon, will receive sealed proposals, at the office of the District at Vale, till Monday, Oct. 2, 1916, at 2 p. m. of said day, for the purchase of Three Hundred and Ninety Thousand Dollars in Gold bonds of Series No. 1, of denomination of \$1000 each, to bear interest as may be determined at time of sale.
