IF THE ROAD BONDS FAIL

The Malheur County Development League with a membership of several hundred progressive ranchers, stockmen, business and professional men has by petition of the people of Malheur county presented a proposal to the county court who have accordingly ordered a special election to raise \$230,000 for the building of better roads thruout Malheur county.

Should the bonds fail the highway commission will be released of its pledge to build the highway thru Malheur county. Should the bond issue fail Malheur county will be branded as the most backward section of the state.

There is every indication that the bond issue will carry four or five to one, and it will if the people who recognize the investment value in better roads realize the necessity of their voting at this election and preventing the possibility of a defeat by default.
