FERTILE SOILS FOR ALFALFA

Crop Does Not Thrive on Land Deficient in Lime—Turn Under Sweet Clover in Fall. Alfalfa will not thrive on poor land, or that which is deficient in lime. Even soils that are moderately fertile and produce good average grain crops will not produce profitable crops of alfalfa unless first limed and then planted in sweet clover.
