Chantecler Salad

The white meat of a cold boiled chicken, % of the same bulk of chopped celery, two hard boiled eggs. one raw egg well beaten, one teaspoon each of salt and pepper, one teaspoon of made mustard, 3 teaspoons of salad oil, two teaspoons white sugar, 1/2 eacup of vinegar. Mince the meat well, removing every scrap of fat, gristle and skin, cut the celery into pieces 1/2 inch long. Mix and set aside to cool while you prepare dressing. Rub the yolks of eggs to a fine powder, add the salt, pepper and sugar; then add the eil, grinding hard and putting in but a few drops at a time. The mustard comes next and let all stand together while you beat the raw egg to a froth. Beat this into the dressing and pour into the vinegar, spoonful by spoonful, whipping the dressing well as you do it. Sprinkle a little dry salt over the meat and celery, toss it up lightly with a silver fork, pour the dressing over it, toss and mixing until the bottom of the mass is as well saturated as the top. Turn into a salad bowl and garnish with a row of white of egg and beets. Cut the white of the egg in rings, then cut through one side of the ring and lace then together in form of a chain; inside this chain put a row of beets cut in pretty shapes with a vegetable cutter. Salads should be served the day they are made. In using oil as a mixture, always use it before putting in the vinegar, to avoid curdling, then add the vinegar, stirring all the time. the meat grinder two or three m Melted butter may be substituted if

Feather Cocoanut Cake

One and one-half cups of flour, seven-eighths cup sugar, two teaspoons baking powder, two tablespoons melted shortening, one egg, one-half cup milk, one teaspoon lemon extract, one-half cup fresh grated cocoanut. Bake in moderate oven 25 minutes; sprinkle with powdered sugar or grated cocoanut.

Coffee Cake

One cup sugar, one cup molasses, cups raisins, one teaspoon cinnamon, one-fourth teaspoon cloves, one teaspoon soda. Put the soda in the coffee, one cup of butter, one cup black coffee, one egg and five cups flour. Bake in moderate oven about

SOUPS AND GARNISHES

Soups will never grow passe, for with too many a soup is the attractive dish of the meal. There are such varieties that he is indeed hard to please who cannot find one to his liking. Vermont Chicken

Soup .- Take six cupfuls of well-seasoned chicken stock, add a little grated onlon, a head of lettuce shredded and one cupful of peas. If the peas are fresh simmer until they are done. Beat an egg, add enough bread crumbs to make a paste and shape into balls. Drop the balls into the soup and simmer until well heated; serve hot.

Quick Bouillon.-Cut fine one pound of fresh beef and a slice of fat pork. Put into a saucepan with one cupful of cold water, one carrot, one onlon finely minced, and cook fifteen minutes; then add two cupfuls of boiling water. Simmer for an hour, then press through a fine sleve. Season

with salt, pepper and celery salt. Cheese Balls.-Take one-half cupful of flour, half a cupful of milk, a tablespoonful each of butter and cheese. Mix in a double boller, cook until smooth and thick, add one egg well beaten and cook long enough to set the egg. Set aside to cool. Form into balls the size of hickory nuts, drop into boiling soup, cook five minutes and serve immediately.

Leftover Meat Dish .- Put through dium-sized potatoes, season well, add one small onion also ground through the meat grinder. In a little pork sausage fat cook the potato and onlon until well scalded then place in a wellbuttered baking pan with a layer of chopped roast beef and garnish with halves of cooked pork sausages. Bake until the potato and onlon are cooked. Serve from the dish. See that all the potato water and onion juice is added for it will be needed for moisture.
