CURTIS IS LECTURING ON KLAN PRINCIPLES

Distinguished Leader Inspiring Men to Higher ideals of Life

Vancouver, Wash., Jan. 17 .- Dr. C. Curtis, pastor of the First Christian Church, of Vancouver, Wash, who re-cently has been appointed offi-cial lecturer for the Ku Klux Klan in' the States of Washington and Idaho, has started the delivering of a series of lectures, under the auspices of Columbi: Klan No. 1 of Vanconver, Wash.
