**ROMAN GARB BANNED IN OREGON SCHOOLS BY LARGE MAJORITY**

**Nevermore Will "Sisters" Abuse Liberty in This Manner.**

Governor Walter M. Pierce of Oregon has signed the bill, which passed both houses of the legislature by a large majority, prohibiting the wearing of any dress or garb of any religious order, sect, or denomination. This puts an everlasting stop to the abuse of liberty by the Roman Catholics, whose "Sisters" in certain counties of Oregon, employed as teachers in the public schools, boldly have been wearing their sectarian garb.

Many legislators expressed a regret that a law cannot be passed to keep the Roman priests from drawing the pay of the "Sisters," who yield up every dollar to them, receiving in return only their garb and meagre board.

The bill was introduced by Mr. Woodward of Portland, Multnomah county.

**Copy of Anti-Garb Bill**

A bill for an act making it unlawful for any teacher in any of the public schools of the State of Oregon to wear in said schools, or while engaged in the performance of his or her duty as such teacher, any dress or garb of any religious sect or denomination; providing a penalty therefor and making it the duty of the board of directors to suspend or expel such teacher.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

Section 1. After the passage of this act, it shall be unlawful for any teacher in any public school in the State of Oregon to wear in said school and while engaged in the performance of his or her duty, any dress or garb of any religious order, sect, or denomination.

Sec. 2. Any teacher violating the provisions of section 1 of this statute shall be immediately suspended from employment in the schools of such district, and such teacher's certificate shall be revoked.

Sec. 3. It is hereby declared to be the duty of the board of directors of any public school district employing a teacher who shall violate the provisions of section 1 of this act, to suspend such teacher from employment in the schools of such district, and to take the necessary action to have such teacher's certificate revoked.

Sec. 4. Every member of the board of directors of any public school district within the State who shall fail to comply with the provisions of section 3 of this act, shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor, and every director, upon the conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not exceeding sixty days (60), or by both fine and imprisonment.

**MAY INDICT PARKER AND CATHOLIC COCO FOR THEIR CONDUCT**

**Washington Correspondent Hears That Louisiana Officials May Have to Pay**

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 7.—The Mer Rouge hearing has produced varying degrees of impressions upon Klansmen and the general public here including members of Congress. These impressions vary from disbelief of half the testimony brought out at the alleged hearing to full belief of all of it.

Klansmen as a whole, however, are disposed to hide their time until the trial when it is believed the Klan will shoot in a whole-hearted manner and show up the diabolical attempt of the Roman church to break up the organization by fastening upon it a murder similar in every detail to the Morgan affair that almost broke up Masonry in the year 1826.

**Klan Wants Men only**

Many weak-kneed Klansmen, however, have shown the white feather during the hearing and some have made moves to withdraw from the Order. In every instance of this kind they have not been encouraged to stay for it is felt here that only MEN are wanted who can stand the GEF when necessary.

Pure and unadulterated "guts" like the variety displayed by Clarence Teagerstrom on the stand at Bastrop is wanted in every Klansman who belongs to the District of Columbia and Northern Virginia bodies.

The manner in which this Klansman told the Catholic Coco that he was a Klansman and had joined while the hearing was at its height is pointed to as the kind of nerve wanted in a Klansman. Teagerstrom has been elevated almost to the level of a hero here by his exemplary conduct.

**May Indict Governor**

The masterful summing up of the case by Judge Barnette, attorney for the accused Klansman at Bastrop, is regarded here as the opening wedge along which lines the Klan will conduct its broadside at the trial. If, indeed, the case ever comes to a trial.

It is reported here that a possible indictment, or certainly a severe criticism of Governor Parker and Attorney-General Coco will be forthcoming when the Grand Jury meets. It is not known upon what charge the Governor could be indicted, but it is known that in some States, criminal action could be taken against a Governor for conduct such as Parker has been guilty of in this debate.

**OREGON STRONGEST STATE IN NUMBERS**

**Major Powell Talking for Press in Evergreen Commonwealth.**

SPOKANE, Wash., Feb. 7.—There are now 48 active chapters of the Ku Klux Klan in Washington.

One hundred new members were initiated into the hooded order in Spokane last night.

In Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Alaska and Hawaiian island are about 300 active chapters.

This information concerning the Ku Klux Klan in Spokane and the northwest was given out today for the first time by Major I. L. Powell of Portland, king kleege of the Pacific northwest domain of the order, who is in Spokane.

"Oregon is the strongest Klan state in the northwest," said Major Powell. "In one Klan alone in Portland there are more than 20,000 members.

"Klans in Washington are not as strong as they are in Oregon and for this reason we have moved our domain headquarters from Portland to Seattle with the idea of increasing membership."

Major Powell declared the klans of Washington were solidly behind the proposed Scottish Rite school law which provides that all children between the ages of eight and 16 years shall attend public schools.

A clause in this bill makes it necessary for the children to graduate from the eighth grade of the public schools, regardless of what their ages may be at the time of graduation, he said.

In speaking of the Bastrop, La., tragedy Major Powell said:

"The Klan had nothing to do with this affair and I am sure that those men reported to have been killed will be found alive.

"Major Powell declared the Klan movements here were very satisfactory. He stated that he would return to the coast.

Major Powell praised highly the wonderful progress of the state organization in Oregon now in charge of Grand Dragon Fred L. Gifford and said Mr. Gifford had "proved himself to be as honest as daylight" and a leader of rare skill and courage.
