Were You . . . What Would You Do?

It is not often that I begin a subject with an apology of self; but in the present case, while realizing the importance of my subject, I also realize the limitations of my elucidation. However, if I do my best, it may encourage someone else to do better.
Let us understand that self is spirit and that the body is simply a physical organism which self uses during this period of life in order to carry out certain demonstrations or work. That the principle attribute of the body is the brain; which being the governing center over the cerebral nervous system, and both a receiver and transmitter of thought vibrations, it should be rightly developed and under the complete control of self, so that self could have a perfect demonstrator through which to work.

We have been told that there is "nothing new under the sun." This may seem difficult to believe, but when thoroughly considered, it is much easier to believe than to disbelieve. For when we review our life, we see that all of our knowledge has been gleaned from others or from experience with things which are.
Whether we receive instruction or information by our sense of hearing, seeing, feeling, tasting, or smelling, the fact is registered upon our receiving brain, the receiving capacity of which determines our understanding of the same. Now, suppose we wish to transmit whatever we have received to someone else; our ability to do so depends wholly upon our transmitting brain and its coordination with the rest of the body. Very often we see persons using all sorts of motions in order to help out their expression for which they seem to lack proper words; yet their signs are a reflection of their thoughts as truly as are words, whether oral or written.
Mind is the entire field of functioning brain. Many people have but a one rut brain. Therefore, properly speaking they have no mind capable of constructive thinking; and such persons are always more or less dangers. Now, follow the thought vibrations of some piece of music from the time it is assembled in the composing brain until it is discharged from a gramophone or wireless and is scattered again through cosmic space. Can anyone demonstrate that these same vibrations may not be, and are, reconstructed according to the harmonizing ability of the brain last receiving them?

I have often discussed the biblical writings with agnostics, and their stock argument is, that these writings cannot be infallible or have come from God through and by inspiration. All truth however or wherever obtained is from COSMIC MIND. When I consider the difficulties under which the biblical writers had to labor; I have but profound admiration and gratitude for them.
With a fair education, a fine L. C. Smith Bros. typing machine, and many other accessories which include an up-to-date dictionary, I began this article with a serious doubt of my ability to transmit to others in an intelligent and understandable manner, that which I know (not believe) is truth; but who, to those who read my article, is hearsay.
Many Protestant ministers now advocate a general revision of the Bible. I hope this may never take place. Anyone who tells too smooth a story is apt to be a water liar than one who is lacking in expression.
If the child is normal, capable of and is developed rightly, the adult will have demonstrating machine with which or she should do good work. But the child brain is perverted, taught to believe that a dago-pope is God on earth, and that dollars will remit wrong, then the adult will, in a loose sense, be but a reflection of his falsehood, deceit, and hypocrisy. And this principle holds good in a manner of teaching.
Remember that thoughts which you receive and set in the memory chambers of your mind today are just such as you are able of receiving; if you desire better thoughts, hook up with a higher thought vibration, and in time you can do your receiving brain so as receive inspirational thought mess off of God's wireless circuit.
The invariable of compensation is too little understood; notwithstanding that have ever before us a multitude of causes with their corresponding fruits. Also, we do not rightly understand our relation to God, and the laws are as binding upon Him as they are upon His children. It is also true as regards obligations duty between our children ourselves.
We are as free ungod's law as is God. We can use anything in our creations and demotions either rightly or wrongly; when we see

Were you elected to the United States Senate, what would you do for our people? and how would you go about doing it? Have you ever given due attention to the bright, honorable men who have been sent to Washington, D. C., followed their career while there, and marked their return to civil life?
Lincoln the rail-splitter, went down there; do you realize why he would go out into the woods and commune with God? Why he, like Jesus, seemed always sad? A man of sorrow! Garfield and Lincoln—both splendid men—went down there and both perished as did Jesus and Lincoln.
Taft went down there and gracefully submitted and is still alive and as fat as ever. "Teddy" went down there and the Tiger vulture sure had something to do in dodging the big stick; but because there was no united action among loyal Americans. Dear Old Teddy did all he could and grieved because the people were so quiescent. Wilson went down there and the devil took him to the palace on the Tiger and painted in glowing words the great honor and dignity of being the first League of Nations President, and poor Wilson is now a soul and body wreck.
Mr. Harding is down there now; and because I know what the thought vibrations which surround him are, I will not write his epitaph at this time; in fact, no one need ever write it. "By their works ye shall know them." Again: "The tree is known by its fruit."
Dewey, when he returned from Manila was the first of our American people; what happened to him? How did it happen? And was not Dewey as really assassinated as was those others I have mentioned, only in a different way?

How many men have gone down there since the Civil War, remained for any considerable time and retained their loyalty to God and Country? Have you ever considered how many noble women have died, have returned to civil life with the shadow of sorrow upon them, or who have got drawn into the quicksands of the social maelstrom of our Capitol City? And have you ever considered how greatly you and I are to blame for existing conditions?
AGAIN, and AGAIN, I ask: WHAT WOULD YOU DO SHOULD YOU GO DOWN AMONG THE PAPAL BRIGHT LIGHTS? Is it not time we should know and judge our functioning government heads by their service and not by papal-press propaganda? It seems to me that it is indeed time we should be reeducated, reborn, that we may have greater appreciation of our just rights and the responsibility which these incur upon us as loyal American citizens.
Let me repeat with emphasis, the man who goes to our National City, without a firm and steadfast loyalty to God, cannot be sure of his loyalty to country, home or friends. The man who thinks that he can sell a part of his real self (soul or spirit) for material gain of any kind, and for a part of the ill gotten gain have his sins remitted, is a very dangerous person to entrust with anything of importance. Yet, this is the teaching of the Vatican agents who swarm around official Washington like vultures around carrion.
Were you a member of the United States Senate, would you guard our national honor, protect the best interests of our people, stand for progressive, constructive legislation only, oppose all measures introduced solely to bring about a graft situation, would you openly proclaim and expose graft methods generally and use all honorable methods to enlighten the people as to the true condition of national affairs?
Would any amount of cash, stock or other corporation paper, usually considered valuable, tempt you to betray the American people? And if you should betray them, would the knowledge that the people robbed, would under our present monetary system, have to pay the amount which you or others might receive from any corporation now controlled, or apparently

controlled by the international bankers, but which are really controlled by the Vatican—cause you any regret or remorse? Do you believe that pope, cardinal, bishop, priest or other person could absolve you of your crime of betrayal?
Do you believe that the square-deal should be our rule and guide in all of our dealings whether public or private? If you do, will you join with me and help institute "Nationalization Exchange at Cost?" Do you believe we can get rid of the papal curse which is now robbing and corrupting our entire social organism?
Our farmers are crushed to a mere existence. Industrial labor has long been and now is, fighting the ever-increasing greed of what is usually termed capital, but which is really the Romish system. Moderate capital is no more free from the blight of this system than are the farmers and others who do useful work.
I have often explained to bankers and business men, how their turn must come as soon as this system has stripped the common people. That the predicted time is now upon us all should realize; bankers with small capital are being crushed by the wholesale banks. The corporation chain-stores are slowly but surely driving out of business the independent dealers. For more than 60 years the work of making the American people destitute has been going on. The fact, that 21 of the 24 million families in the United States, are without home ownership should convince the most skeptical that my deductions are true.
Whether man or woman, old or young, if you believe in the wisdom, love, truth and justice of God, if you wish to be loyal to country, home and friends, begin today the building of character by doing small duties well, keeping small obligations faithfully, help those who are weaker than yourself all you can, and never cease trying to develop your brain so that it will harmonize with the higher circuits of thought vibrations.
For more than 200 years it has been generally believed that the so-called bank of England was owned and controlled by the Rothschilds. If the testimony of these Jew renegades is to be relied upon at all, we have it from them: "It is not our money, it is the Vatican's money we have."
If we will compare this statement with the fact that deceased J. P. rule and abuse, our allowing them to even start their evil system in America, is nothing less than criminal carelessness.
